

The European Veteran Roller hockey Invitational Cup on the international calendar?

COMITE EUROPEEN RINK-HOCKEY (C.E.R.H.) VERY MUCH INTERESTED IN THE EVRICUP

Delft- The development of the European Veteran Roller hockey Invitational Cup (EVRICup) is adopted by many international roller hockey lovers and intensively followed, according to the many responses and the number of visits to the General website of the EVRICup.

The Board of the International Committee EVRICup (I.E.C.) had a first contact with the President of the C.E.R.H., Mr Carlos Graca, during the last European Championships roller hockey for Men in Wuppertal (Germany).

The intention is to organize a meeting between the C.E.R.H. and I.E.C. in Sintra (Portugal) during the following edition (16) of the EVRICup (June 8-11 2011) to explore each other's objectives.

It is important for the I.E.C. that the sporting character of the event is guaranteed and that the event receives an official international status. Placement on the International (C.E.R.H.) roller hockey calendar would be a nice result. Many veterans from the 35 + and 50 + categories have an obligation as director, trainer or coach on federal- or club level in their country and they cannot meet regularly because of conflicts with the dates of the EVRICup editions.

There are a lot more people who want to participate in an EVRICup event. By placement on the international roller hockey calendar the EVRICup gets a protected status making it possible for each and everyone to play and watch his favorite game on an international veterans level and keep in contact with international roller hockey friends.
