01. **Name event**
The official name of the event is European Veteran Rollerhockey Invitational Cup (EVRI Cup).
02. **Mission European Veteran Rollerhockey Invitational Cup**
Promotion for the international veteran rollerhockey in the categories 35+ and 50+ and give an international contribution to development the kind of sport rollerhockey.

04. **Information about de EVRI Cup circuit**
The I.E.C. starts a website with information about the EVRI Cup circuit. The address of the website is : www.evricup.com. Contact webmaster : info@evricup.com
05. **EVRI Cup editions**
Each year is an EVRI cup edition in Spring and Autumn of that year. Started in the year 2011 there will one edition each year (autumn). The event will take place on the days Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The participating teams must at last arrived on Thursday 12.00 hour on location of the EVRI Cup edition.
06. **Requirements participating teams**
For the category 35+ the players have to be 35 years or older at the first day of the edition they participate in.
For the category 50+ the players have to be 50 years or older at the first day of the edition they participate in.
During the delegates meeting on Thursday the I.E.C. receives the playerslist of the delegates of the teams and a passport/identity card control is possible.
07. **Culture moment**
A special moment for the participators is the culture moment in the area (city or region) of the EVRI Cup edition. Organization of the culture moment is in the hands of the organization committee of that present EVRI Cup edition. The moment is the Thursday of the event between 11.00 and 13.30 hour.
08. **Rules of the game**
The EVRI Cup competitions 35+ and 50+ follow the rules of the FIRS/CIRH (date June 2009). Game protests are not possible.

09. Requirement organization EVRI Cup edition

1. An international (covered) roller hockey accommodation;
2. Competitions categories 35+ and 50+;
3. Representative referees (group fase : 1 referee, finals : 2 referees);
4. A room for the delegates meeting on Thursday;
5. The traditional EVRI cup dinner on Saturday;
6. An EVRI Cup edition website (starting two months before the event);
7. Using the EVRI Cup logo in all communications;
8. Culture supply for the participators on Thursday;
9. During the games presence first medical aid.

10. Delegates meeting

At the beginning of every EVRI Cup edition there shall be held a Delegatesmeeting.

Commentary

Each team plays no more than two games a day. When it is necessary to play three games a day, there will be two hours rest between the games.

11. Standard prices of a EVRI Cup edition

The following prices are in the categories 35+ and 50+:

1. *The European Veteran Rollerhockey Invitational Cup* for the number 1 in the category 35+. This cup is a challenge-cup and the I.E.C. is the owner of this cup and the 35+ winner can hold this cup for half a year (so until the next edition)
2. *The Jaime Labory Memorial Cup*, This cup is a challenge-cup and the I.E.C. is the owner of this cup and the winner (a exceptional person or team) can hold this cup for a half year (so until the next edition).
3. A cup for the number 1 in the category 35+
4. Cups for the ranking place 2 to 10/12 in category 35+
5. A cup for the number 1 in the category 50+
6. Cups for the ranking places 2 until 4 in the category 50+

12. Responsibility

The I.E.C. and the organization committee of the present EVRI Cup edition can not be jointly and severally liable.

13. Contribution participating teams

The present EVRI Cup organization committee has the possibility to ask a financial contribution at the participating teams in the situation that the organization committee has problems to fit the event budget : between the 150,= and 250,= euro each team at 12 players and delegates.

14. EVRI Cup calendar
